Midwest and East Coast Formula Car Challenge Regions Meet at The June Sprints

The seventh race for the Formula Car Challenge - Midwest was part of the historic June Sprints held at Road America in Elkhart Lake Wisconsin and took place on the weekend of June 25, 2010. This event was a dual event with the East Coast region of the Formula Car Challenge. It was a winner take all battle between the North and the South.



Road America provided its normal unpredictable Wisconsin weather. The first qualifying session was held in near perfect conditions. Mike Anderson was able to qualify at an impressive 2:16.4.

The second qualifier was on a damp track which relegated the session to nothing more than a practice for the race.

The race started and Juan Marchand demonstrated his car's superior straight-line speed as he easily drove by the quicker qualifiers. On the third lap, while battling for the lead, Mike Anderson and Juan Marchand had a spectacular and controversial collision which spread parts across the entire track. This caused a full-course caution and a lengthy clean up. Doug Peterson was the beneficiary of the leaders' demise and went on to win the race.


About the Formula Car Challenge presented by Goodyear

For 2010 there are four Formula Car Challenge regions; The West Coast Region promoted by World Speed Inc, the South West Region promoted by Texas Autosports, the East Coast Region promoted by The Speed Connection, and the Mid West Region promoted by Lake Effect Motorsports.
