Following Will Power's Example: Cameron and McCallum Win it All at the Indy GP of Sonoma 35 Goodyear equipped Mazda powered racers battled it out at the Infineon Raceway Double Header

Sonoma, CA August 23rd, 2010

IZOD IndyCar Series racer Will Power took the top spot in qualifying, and led wire-to-wire this weekend to



seal the IndyCar road course championship. A couple of Formula Car Challenge presented by Goodyear racer's, who were paddocked in the center of all the action this weekend, took note of his dominance and followed Power's lead.

In the Pro Formula Mazda (PFM) class Dane Cameron placed himself on pole for race one with a time of 1:29.147. Alan McCallum took the lead spot in the Formula Mazda (FM) class with a time of 1:35.737.

Race one was a fairly clean event with 32 of the 35 cars finishing under their own power. The drivers who visited

the podium that day were Dane Cameron 1st, Patrick O'Neill 2nd, and Cole Morgan 3rd. The FM Podium was Alan McCallum 1st, Doug Peterson 2nd, and Joe Colasacco.

Then on Sunday things got a bit more messy. In Sunday's IndyCar race Dan Weldon's car got flipped upside down before he ever even saw the green flag. The balance of the IndyCar race was a rough and tumble battle. This was a preview of how some of Sunday's race in the Formula Car Challenge presented by Goodyear was going to be. Sunday's race was a bonus race, and drivers were placed on the grid in order of their performance in Saturday's race. There were multiple full course yellows that made for some very exciting restarts, but unfortunately also ended the day for a handful of racers.



In the end the PFM podium was a replay of Saturday with Dane Cameron 1 st, Patrick O'Neill 2nd, and Cole Morgan 3rd. The FM Podium featured Alan McCallum at the top followed by Lucas Barnett and Bill Weaver.

This was the first time that the Formula Car Challenge presented by Goodyear has been a featured race at the Indy Grand Prix of Sonoma. "We really have to applaud the participants, who made the event the rip roaring show that it was," stated Series Official Ben Hettema. "We also have to thank the entire staff at Infineon Raceway, the Indy Racing League, and the National Auto Sport Association who were all great to work with and made the event go extremely well."













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This year, The Indy Grand Prix of Sonoma marks the 40th anniversary of the first-ever open-wheel race ever held in Sonoma back in 1970. The Indy Grand Prix of Sonoma had some very special promotions to celebrate the anniversary including special ticket packages that allowed fans to meet Danica Patrick and Mario Andretti.

The Formula Car Challenge presented by Goodyear heads to Miller Motorsports Park in Utah next for the NASA National Championships on September 16th -19th.
